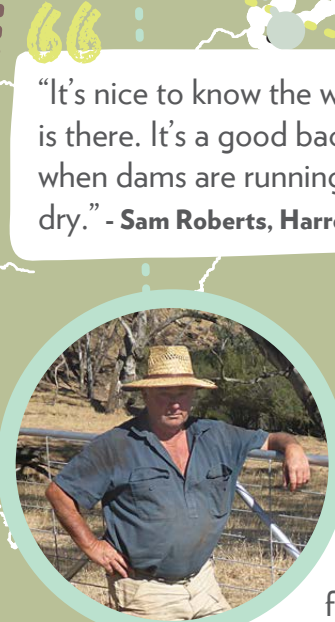

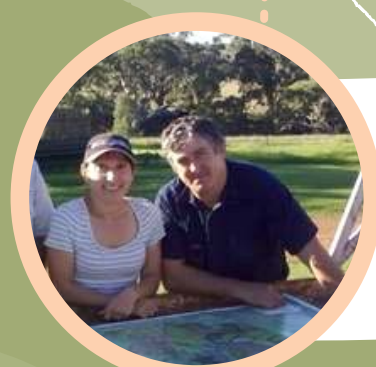

Environmental flows have the decreased salinity of the upper Glenelg River providing fresher water for stock to drink. This has real benefits for the many farmers using the river for stock and domestic purposes.

85% of landholders in the upper Glenelg region rely on a healthy Glenelg River for stock and domestic water supply.

73% increase in times where environmental flows have made water suitable for stock to drink.

80% reduction of salinity concentrations due to flows, an important benefit for downstream users.

\$34 million estimated in total benefits to the economy contributed from environmental flows in the Glenelg River.
