
Glenelg Hopkins CMA Swamp Stewardships North Eastern Volcanic Plains area

Do you have a farm in the North Eastern Volcanic Plains area with swamps or wetlands on your property?

Expressions of Interest are now open to support landholders wanting to know more about these wet areas of their farm, how to manage them, and how to be paid to support them.

Glenelg Hopkins CMA's Our Catchments Our Communities (OCOC) project can help financially through partnerships to support stewardship of seasonal swamps.

The North Eastern Volcanic Plains is a productive farming area in a landscape of swamps. Swamps are the sumps of the farm, providing drainage, summer green pick for livestock and habitat for broilgas, frogs and other animals as well as beneficial insects.

Healthy swamps can be part of a productive farm, and with the right support this can be easily achieved.

Funding is available to farmers who own property in the North Eastern Volcanic Plains area (see map) to manage their seasonal swamps. The support is for assessing and better understanding the swamps on your farm through to stewardship agreements with financial incentives for swamp management and/or restoration.
