Get a good understanding on how to make the most of nutrients in effluent to grow pasture. This is especially helpful now when urea prices are high and there is uncertainty about availability.

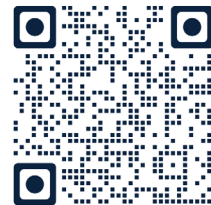
